

### THE MINISTRY OF PRESENCE



"Let us not underestimate how hard it is to be compassionate. Compassion is hard because it requires the inner disposition to go with others to the place where they are weak, vulnerable, lonely, and broken. But this is not our spontaneous response to suffering.

What we desire most is to do away with suffering by fleeing from it or finding a quick cure for it. As busy, active, relevant ministers, we want to earn our bread by making a real contribution. This means first and foremost doing something to show that our presence makes a difference.

And so we ignore our greatest gift, which is **our ability to enter into solidarity with those who suffer.** Those who can sit in silence with their fellow man, not knowing what to say but knowing that they should be there, can bring new life to a dying heart. Those who are not afraid to hold a hand in gratitude, to shed tears in grief and to let a sigh of distress arise straight from the heart can break through paralyzing boundaries and witness the birth of a new fellowship, the fellowship of the broken."

#### **VALIDATION**

Validation is a way you can communicate acceptance and support to the individual. It is the acceptance of their emotions, behaviors, and feelings as understandable. Painful feelings that are acknowledged will fade with time, painful feelings that are ignored will strengthen.

#### **EMPATHY**

The act of perceiving, understanding, experiencing and responding to the emotional state and ideas of another person.




#### **OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS**

Open-ended questions elicit a response that cannot be answered with a "yes," "no," or a simple fact. This type of questioning allows for more dialogue and less of an interrogation style conversation.

#### **PARTIALIZING**

Helps the individual break down multiple or complex parts of the situation into more manageable units so you can address them more easily together.
