The Planning Process

The Planning team at St. Peter's, consisting of leaders in the parish community along with members of the Par- ish Council, began this strategic planning process in the fall of 2020. Meetings were mostly held virtually. The team looked at the community demographics and the current state of the parish. The community has experi- enced slightly declining growth in population, and predict in the next 5 years the median age of residents will continue to increase. Our people are generous, despite the fact that many are on a limited income. We have many vacationers who are part of our parish family. Many of the families who call Garrett County their home do not have younger children in their households. The team also noted that Mass attendance has been declining, as has sacramental participation. The financial state of the parish is improving since the arrival of Fr. Gills as pastor.

Once the team defined **Our Sacred Purpose** and **Our Vision** for St. Peter's, we looked at the six Core Mission Priorities and how our Mission Team structure would address the strategies/initiatives that the parish would use under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, to move the culture of the parish forward.





- 3. Increase visibility and participation in Eucharistic Adoration . (L.M.T.)
- 4. Enhance the liturgical celebration through music, décor worship aids (L.M.T.)
- Prepare parish liturgies and music in accordance with the various liturgical seasons. (L.M.T.)★
- 2. Initial and on-going training of all extraordinary liturgical ministers (L.M.T.)★
- 3. Feedback, ongoing support, and assessment to parish clergy regarding the liturgical life of the parish & how it can be enhanced. (*L.M.T.*)★
